In addition, the plan addresses fundamental test actions such as:

- 1) data regression of Operating Functions / Accounting / Taxation / Reporting / Extraction / Interfaces
- 2) attempts to foil Security and Crash Recovery
- 3) Functional / Unit / Integrated / System / Stress / Beta / pre-Live Pilot sequencing

XeC's goal is to test systems that have passed basic error testing and specification matching, but were deemed unusable by the users, and offer the developers additional useful data on usability. XeC will test with an understanding of the industry and the daily business processes.
